

	Kadesh- קדש - Kiddush
	Urhatz - ערחת - hand washing without a blessing
	Karpas כרפס - dipping a vegetable
	Yahatz יחצץ - breaking the middle matzah
	Maggid - מגיד - telling the story and asking questions
	Rachtzah - רחצתה - hand washing with a blessing
	Motzi Matzah - מוציא מצה - eating matzah
	Marrow - מרור - bitter vegetables
	Korech - כורך - Hillel sandwich
	Shulchan Orech - שולחן עורך - The meal
	Tzafun - צפונ - Afikomen
	Barekh - ברכך - Birkat ha-mazon
	Hallel - הallel - singing Psalms
	Nirtazah - נרצה - Concluding songs

First cup

Third cup - Birkat Ha-Mazon

4th cup - Hallel
